**The arena**

Successful management of safety, health & environmental risk is central to enabling AstraZeneca meet its business goals. You will be part of a European technical leadership team in the Occupational Safety, Health & Environment (OSHE) Team with primary responsibility for providing support to AstraZeneca in Sweden but also supporting the AstraZeneca business internationally where required. You will therefore work in co-operation with the local OSHE delivery teams (in Sweden & UK), the technical lead in the UK and also AstraZeneca's corporate SHE function.

**The role**

The role is to provide technical leadership & governance for the management of risks associated with workplace exposure to hazardous substances, noise & vibration. This includes:

- Developing and managing the strategy for managing the risks through assessment of the controls in place (physical & procedural) and implementation of prioritized improvements in conjunction with the customer functions.
- Providing specialist advice and support services (e.g. measurement/monitoring surveys) to the business.
- Acting as the focal point for contact with Regulatory Authorities, interpreting changes to legislation and leading/supporting implementation of these in the business.
- Taking ownership for the associated risk/compliance management processes by ensuring documented procedures are in place, effective and the principle of continuous improvement is applied
- Identifying and developing the capability & competence necessary to effectively manage the risks either internally in AstraZeneca, or externally via contract resource.
- Providing specialist input to accident & incident investigations, audits, risk assessment etc.

In addition, as part of the technical leadership team, you may also take responsibility for elements of the overall SHE Management System and leading/supporting other SHE improvement initiatives.

**Minimum experience**

- Degree in relevant science or engineering discipline
- Significant experience working in occupational & environmental hygiene including practical experience of:
  - Evaluating exposure risk (physical & chemical)
  - Techniques to control exposure
  - Measuring/monitoring of exposure
- Good knowledge of relevant legislation, and risk management principles/practices
- Good inter-personal and communication skills (both written & verbal), including use of English Language

- Proven ability to lead successful delivery of improvement projects
